Incorporating as a Not-For-Profit entity.

Present Status

- The Mono Pickleball Club (“MPC”) was founded in 2022 to help develop and grow the sport of pickleball in the Town of Mono and surrounding communities.
- The Club has been very successful with membership growing to over 300 members with home courts at Mono College Park
- Management of MPC is currently overseen by a board of directors

Advantages of remaining as an *unincorporated not-for-profit*

- **Flexibility:**
 - less regulatory requirements, more flexibility and lower operating costs
- **Less Reporting:**
 - do not have to file annual corporate reports nor prepare annual financial statements

Advantages of becoming an *incorporated not-for-profit*

- Limited liability:
 - in the event of a bankruptcy or lawsuit, the Directors', Officers' and members' personal assets will be protected
- Fundraising:
 - Being incorporated increases the level of trust from funding providers and helps facilitate the grant application process
- Tax Benefits:
 - generally exempt from paying income tax
- Permanence:
 - An incorporated not-for-profit can exist perpetually
