Coaching and Clinic Policy

Rationale:

- For consistency of coaching methods and philosophy.
- For the safety of participants.

Guidelines and Procedures:

1) Fees and Expenses

- a) Clinics and coaching sessions offered to MPC members will be self-funded, including, but not limited to, the venue fee and fee for coaches.
- b) Revenue, beyond expenses, for clinics coaching sessions will be reserved for future use such as planning and/or other instructional activities and considered restricted funds in the Club budget.
- c) Equipment and supplies for clinics and other coaching opportunities will be paid from the restricted funds from clinics with the approval of the Board.
- d) Remuneration to coaches will be set by the Board and reviewed periodically, at least once per year.

2) Instructors

- a) Instructors must be MPC members.
- b) Instructors providing clinics and instruction to MPC members must have participated in and passed a minimum of the NCCP Level 1 Instructors course.
- c) Instructors will plan, arrange venues, and create PCNS events as necessary for registration, contacts and fees.
- d) Mono College Park court time and usage must be approved by the Board for all planned instruction sessions and/or clinics.
- e) Instructor behaviour must be consistent with their training, and MPC, PO and PC Code of Conduct.
- f) When more than one instructor is involved in a session/clinic, the instructors will plan as a team and implement the plan cooperatively.

3) Just Cause: Instructors may be dismissed by the Board for any actions contrary to the Vision, Mission and Code of Conduct of the Mono Pickleball Club. The Board may also remove the instructor from the membership in the Club. (see Membership Policy/Just Cause).
